Objectives:

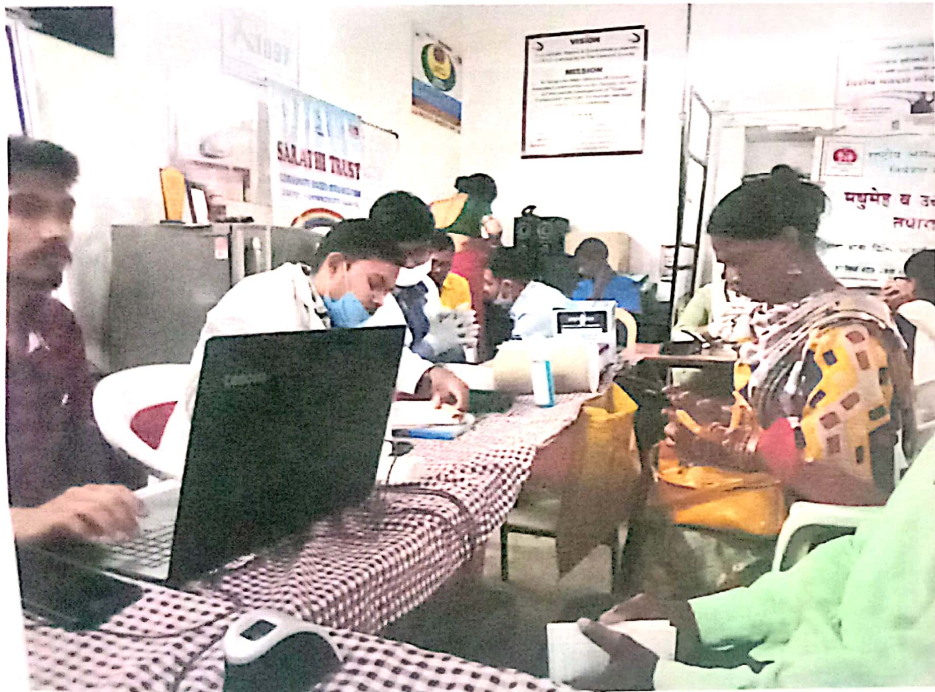
1. To participate in Health Check-up Camp for LGBTQ & TG Community

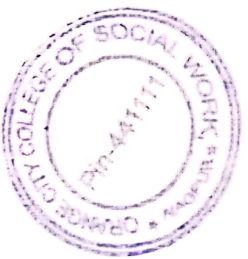

3. To remind students about the tireless work of Maharaj towards people welfare.

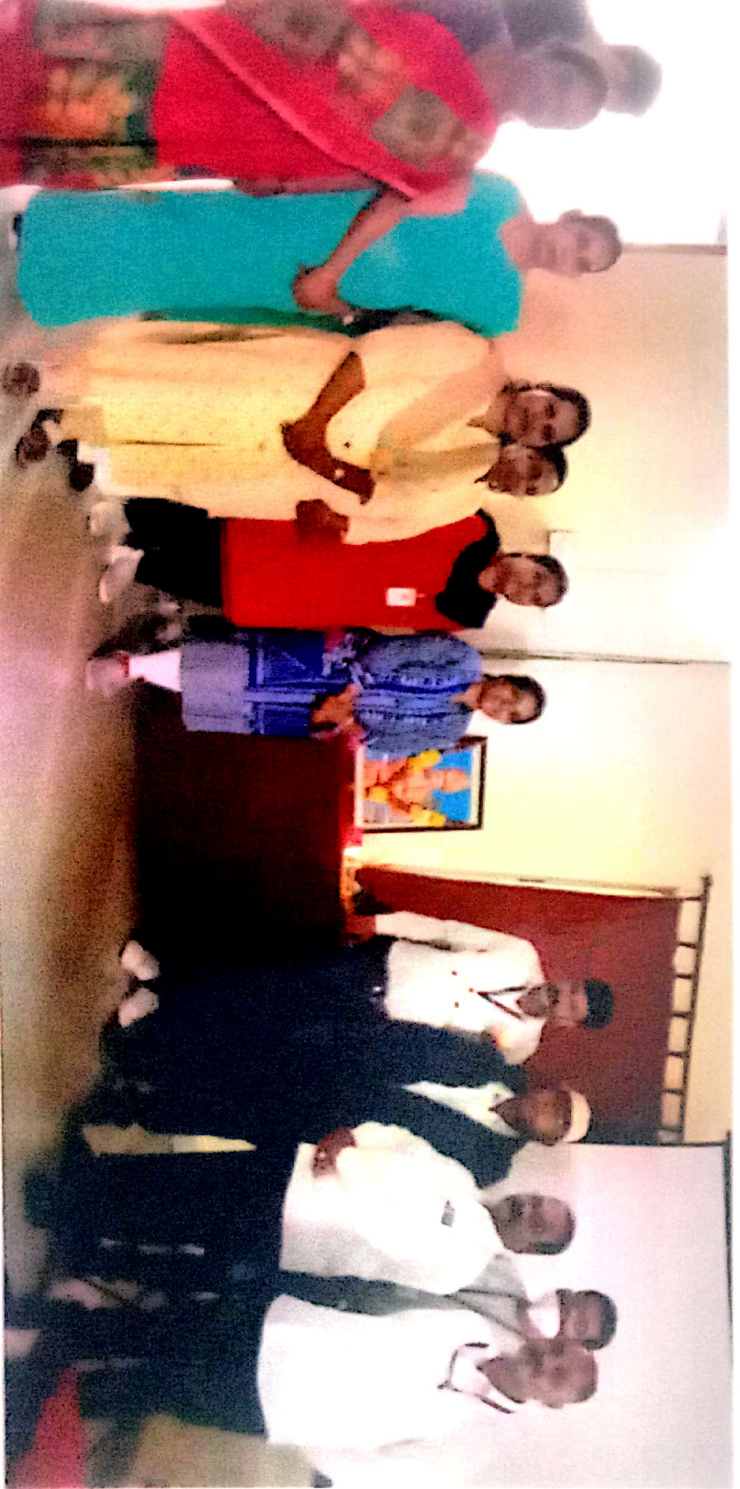
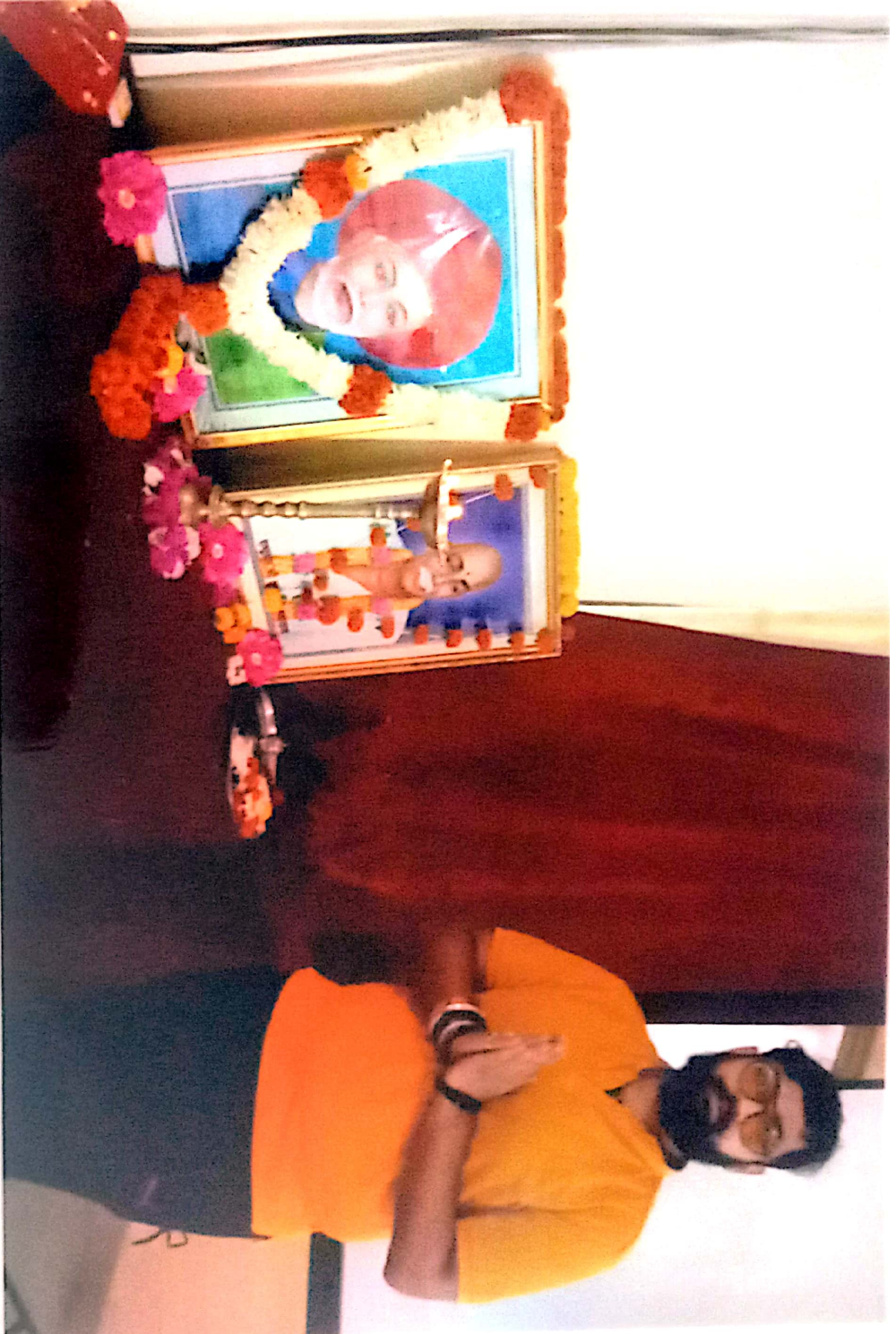
Program:
