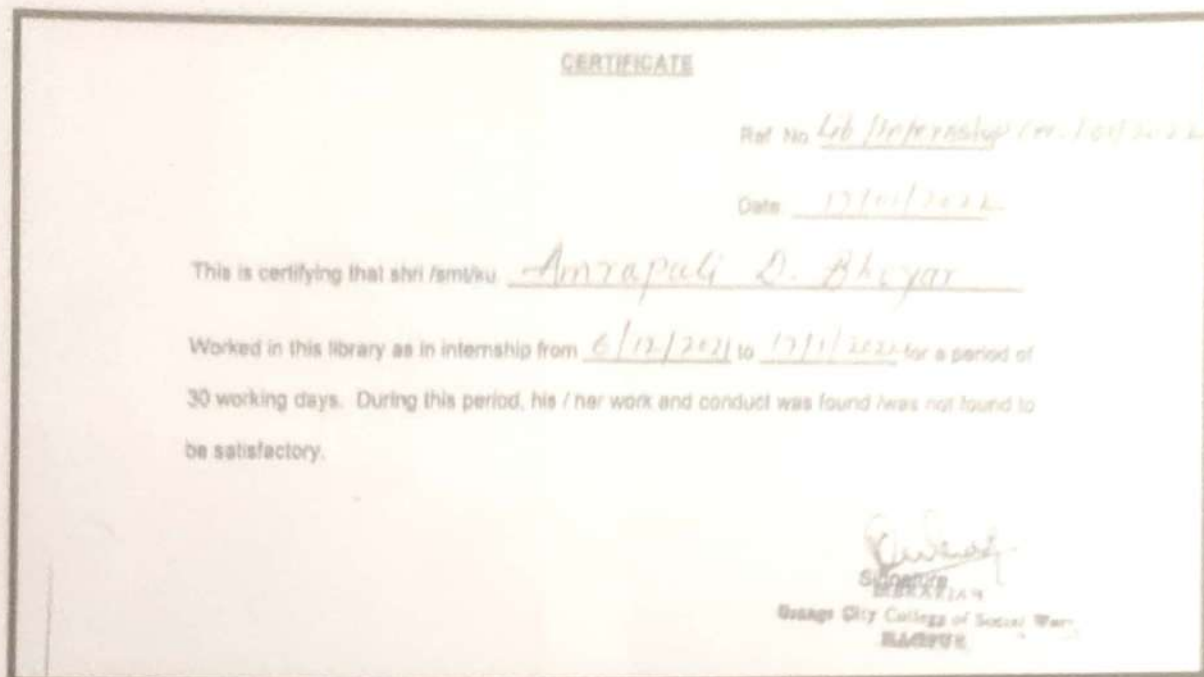
software from official website of eGranthalaya also giving demo session of software from website. Hands on session also given to the students for clearing their doubts and concepts while actually facing the automation software.

A One-Day Workshop on 'Intellectual Property Rights'

Date: 9th October, 2021

Introduction:

A one-day workshop on 'Intellectual Property Rights' was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell was organized at the college. The workshop was organized with the aim of creating awareness regarding the concept of Intellectual Property Rights. The chief guest of the programme Hon. Dr. Manju Dubey, Librarian, R. S. Mundle College of Arts and Commerce, Nagpur, Mr. Kshitij Gupta, Regional Publicity Head, Rashtriya Swayam-Sevak Sangh, Nagpur, Mr. Irfan Khan, Managing Director, BNA Online News, Nagpur, Mr. Kamal Nampalliwar, President, BNA Online News, Nagpur and Dr. Chandansingh Rotele, Hon. President, Rotele Group of Institution, India guided the students regarding Intellectual Property Rights.

Dr. Manju Dubey opined that the rights of authors of literary and artistic works (such as books and other writings, musical compositions, paintings, sculpture, computer programs and films) are protected by copyright, for a minimum period of 50 years after the death of the author.

Also protected through copyright and related (sometimes referred to as "neighbouring") rights are the rights of performers (e.g. actors, singers and musicians), producers of phonograms (sound recordings) and broadcasting organizations. The main social purpose of protection of copyright and related rights is to encourage and reward creative work.

The industrial property can usefully be divided into two main areas: One area can be characterized as the protection of distinctive signs, in particular trademarks (which distinguish the goods or services of one undertaking from those of other undertakings) and geographical indications (which identify a good as originating in a place where a given characteristic of the good is essentially attributable to its geographical origin).

The protection of such distinctive signs aims to stimulate and ensure fair competition and to protect consumers, by enabling them to make informed choices between various goods and services. The protection may last indefinitely, provided the sign in question continues to be distinctive. Other types of industrial property are protected primarily to stimulate innovation,

design and the creation of technology. In this category fall inventions (protected by patents), industrial designs and trade secrets.

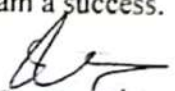
Mr. Kshitij Gupta, Regional Publicity Head, Rashtriya Swayam-Sevak Sangh, Nagpur opined that the social purpose is to provide protection for the results of investment in the development of new technology, thus giving the incentive and means to finance research and development activities. A functioning intellectual property regime should also facilitate the transfer of technology in the form of foreign direct investment, joint ventures and licensing. The protection is usually given for a finite term (typically 20 years in the case of patents). While the basic social objectives of intellectual property protection are as outlined above, it should also be noted that the exclusive rights given are generally subject to a number of limitations and exceptions, aimed at fine-tuning the balance that has to be found between the legitimate interests of right holders and of users.

Mr. Kamal Nampalliwar, President, BNA Online News, Nagpur opined that Intellectual Property (IP) at colleges and universities refers most importantly to the products of faculty, staff, and student research and scholarship. IP falls into two groups—work covered by patent law and work covered by copyright law. Both categories have undergone significant change over the last generation. In response, university policies have either evolved or been radically revised. Mr Irfan Khan, Managing Director, BNA Online News, Nagpur said that the most troubling changes have occurred in university patent policies, with major research universities leading the way in limiting or eliminating faculty members' traditional rights to decide what happens to their discoveries or inventions.

Dr. Chandansingh Rotele, Hon. President, Gram Utkarsh Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur many campus copyright policies remain good, but they are being undermined by the online course revolution, including the wave of interest in massive open online courses (MOOCs), since many institutions have sought to deny faculty members their traditional rights to the instructional materials they author. Campus patent policies, however, have taken a radical turn for the worse, with a number of campuses revising them to mandate automatic institutional ownership of the fruits of scholarly work. We provide recommended language both for patent and online instruction policies.

Conclusion:

The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Vijay Tupe, who expressed his gratitude to Dr. Manju Dubey for sparing her valuable time and sharing her expertise with the faculties and students.
