A Report of One Day State Level Seminar on Unravelling the University Act, 2016

Date: 20 August, 2021

Introduction: An One Day State Level Seminar on Unravelling the University Act, 2016 was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell at the college. The seminar was organized with the aim of creating awareness regarding the concept of Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016. The chief guest of the seminar Dr. Sanjay Dudhe sir, Hon. Pro Vice Chancellor, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur, Dr. Chandansingh Rotele, Hon. President, Gram Utkarsh Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur, the Special Invitee, Dr. Kalpanatai Pandey, President, Vidyapeeth Shikshan Manch and Ex-Mayor, Nagpur, Dr. Satish Chafle, Mahamantri, Vidyapeeth Shikshan Manch and Dr. Yogesh Bhute, IQAC Coordinator, Sindhu Mahavidyalay, Nagpur guided the participants regarding nuances of University Act, 2016. On this occasion the center for M-SET Coaching and Guidance Center at the college was inaugurated.

The Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016 provides for academic autonomy and excellence, adequate representation through democratic process, transformation, strengthening and regulating higher education and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. Maharashtra Public Universities Act came into force on Wednesday after the state government issued a gazette that the Act that was effective from 1 March, 2016.

The seminar was inaugurated by the chief guest of the workshop **Dr. Chandansingh Rotele, Hon. President, Gram Utkarsh Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur**. He said that the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 came into force on after the state government issued a gazette. There had been major reform in Maharashtra's higher education sector — which had been praised by various legislators, political leaders and college principals — has finally been implemented.

The Maharashtra Public Universities Bill, 2016 was passed by the state Legislative Assembly and Council in December last year. The Act aims at providing academic autonomy to state universities, improve their functioning and bring about higher participation of students.

The highlights of the Act: Structured governance through a board of deans and directors in-charge of various subjects, restarting the students' council elections which were banned in 1994 due to the death of a student, introduction of choice-based credit system for students, a disputes redressal system for students and a fee-fixation committee. The bill won't be applicable to the medical and agriculture universities.

His discourse was followed by the speech of **Dr. Sanjay Dudhe, Hon. Pro Vice Chancellor, RTMNU, Nagpur**. The Act states that each university will now be governed by the vice-chancellor, pro-vice chancellor, deans of faculties and seven directors. Besides, there will be a registrar, finance and accounts officer and director of sub-campuses of the university.

The Act would allow universities to conduct Board of Studies (BoS) elections, which were held up by the government for over one-and-a-half years.

Many important functions like making appointments to top posts and conducting students' elections can be implemented only after statutes are out by the end of this month. "While officials such as the registrar, examination controller, who were appointed before, can continue to hold offices till the term for which they were appointed, the post of the director of board of college and university development became redundant from Wednesday," said the report.

Under the new Act, a system has been set up to grant permission to new colleges. It will offer a letter of intent for the first year during which the colleges will have to complete infrastructure building and creation of facilities. After the new college has been scrutinised for facilities, the university will then grant permission to run such colleges. The Act stresses on setting up of equal opportunity cell for *divyang* students and setting up of a Vishakha cell to redress complaints of sexual harassment of women. A proposal has also been made to make compulsory mercantile (double entry) accounting system to bring transparency. To prevent profiteering by unaided institutions affiliated to universities, the Act proposes to set up special committee to determine fees and a regulatory mechanism at the state-level.

The first draft of the Act was prepared by a committee headed by former University Grants Commission (UGC) chairman Arun Nigavekar in 2011. It then took the government over five years to get the state legislature's approval for the law. During that period, the then bill underwent many amendments.

The amended bill was tabled by State Education Minister Vinod Tawde in the House in December. He said, the bill was passed by a joint panel of 25 legislators from both Houses after making as many as 56 amendments. The panel also comprised two former education ministers, college owners and experts from various fields.

The composition of statutory bodies has remained more or less the same but while the Act has added two new posts for representatives of colleges in the Senate and one in the academic council, the proportion of nominated members has increased. Now there will be at least 71 members in the Senate and half of them will be elected representatives. This has left teachers' unions and former senate members disappointed.

No educational institution situated within the university area shall, except with the consent of the university and the sanction of the State Government, be associated in any way with, or seek admission to any privilege of, any other university established by law with the exception of the

regard to the welfare of various categories of weaker sections of the society, minorities, women and persons with disability as directed by the State Government, from time to time.

The Board of Studies shall have the following powers and duties, namely:—

- (a) to recommend to the Management Council through the faculty or faculties concerned and the Academic Council, the introduction of new diplomas and degrees;
- (b) to recommend to the Management Council through the faculty or faculties concerned and the Academic Council, the discontinuation of diplomas and degrees which have become irrelevant;
- (c) to recommend to the faculty concerned, the course syllabi, course structures and evaluation schemes of various courses;
- (d) to recommend to the reference books or supplementary reading books and such other material useful for study of the course;
- (e) to recommend to the faculty, modifications in respect of addition or deletion or updating of courses;
- (f) to prepare the panels of paper-setters, examiners and moderators for the university examinations and evaluation, based on the criteria laid down by the Academic Council and recommend them to the Board of Examination and Evaluation;
- (g) to suggest to the Dean of the faculty concerned, organization of orientation and refresher courses in the subject in the summer or winter vacations;
- (h) to prepare the requirements with regard to library, laboratory, equipment in respect of courses concerned;
- (i) to suggest extension programmes with respect to the courses introduced;
- (j) to understand the requirements of industry or corporate or society at large and to incorporate them into the syllabi to make the teaching-learning process relevant to the needs of the time;
- (k) to encourage learning by collaboration and participation by using information and communication technology tools;
- (l) to design curricula, add vocational content to every discipline and to prescribe the minimum period to pursue skill development programme and the level of proficiency expected.

The powers and duties of Board of studies to ratify curricula, all processes and practices developed by the autonomous colleges, university departments or institutions, autonomous recognized institutions, empowered autonomous colleges or cluster of institutions, empowered skills development colleges, and recommendations in respect of recognition of teachers or experts.

state open university and Research or Project collaborations of university, colleges with any other university or colleges: Provided that, if an educational institution, public or private, Indian or foreign, seeks to be associated with or be admitted to the privileges of a university, jurisdiction of which is not restricted to any State or area, such association or admission may be permitted by the State Government.

Provided further that, if a university, the jurisdiction of which is not restricted to any State or area, wishes to establish a centre or other unit of research in the university area on its own or in collaboration with any public or private Indian or foreign university or institution, it may do so with the sanction of the State Government and also with the sanction of the Central Government, if the collaboration is with the foreign university or institution.

If an educational institution, public or private, Indian or foreign, associated with or admitted to the privileges of any other university established by law, seeks to be associated with, or be admitted to the privileges of a university, such association or admission may be permitted with the sanction of the State Government and consent of the university concerned.

Save as otherwise provided by or under this Act, any privilege enjoyed by any educational institution within the area of another university before the date on which this Act comes into force, shall not be withdrawn, without the sanction of the State Government.

If a new district is created by the State Government, the area of such district shall be under the jurisdiction of such university, as may be declared by the State Government, by notification in the Official Gazette, for the purpose of admission to the privileges of such university. No citizen of India shall be excluded from any office of the university or from membership of any of its authorities, bodies or committees, or from appointment to any post, or from admission to any degree, diploma, certificate or other academic distinction or course of study on the ground only of sex, race, creed, class, caste, place of birth, religious belief or profession or political or other opinion: Provided that, the university may maintain, accredit or recognize any college or institution exclusively for women, or reserved for women. The university shall adopt government policy and orders issued, from time to time, in regard to the reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes and Other Backward Classes for appointment to different posts of teachers and non-teaching employees and for the purpose of admission of students in the affiliated or conducted or community colleges, university departments, university institutions or recognized institutions. The university shall adopt with the general policy of the State Government in

There shall be a Board of University Departments and Interdisciplinary Studies to promote interdisciplinary education and research on campus and also network with national and international institutions and create an academic and research and development environment that allows free flow of ideas amongst several disciplines. The Board of University Departments and Interdisciplinary Studies shall consist of the following members, namely the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Chairperson; the Deans of faculties and Associate Deans, if any; four experts, to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor from other universities or national level research and development laboratories, one each having minimum experience of five years as a professor or equivalent position in research and development laboratories, in each of the disciplines of science, technology, humanities, commerce and management and interdisciplinary studies; four heads of departments or senior professors representing various subjects or disciplines in an equitable manner, to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor; the Dean of Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies shall act as a Member-Secretary; The Board shall meet at least three times a year.

Dr. Mahendrakumar Meshram, Hon. Principal, Orange City College of Social Work, Nagpur said that the Board of University Departments and Interdisciplinary Studies shall have the following powers and duties, namely: to devise long term policy and strategy for promotion of quality postgraduate education on university campus; to prepare a comprehensive development plan for post-graduate education in university departments; to work on annual financial estimates (budget) for university departments; to co-ordinate the research and development activities with the Board of Research; to establish linkages with foreign and Indian premier teaching and research and development institutions or universities for strengthening of teaching and research and development activities on the campus of the university; to work in tandem with the Board of National and International Linkages to collaborate with national and international agencies, universities (including deemed or self-financed universities) and institutions for sharing of academic resources, running joint teaching programmes, running joint degree programmes with national and international universities or institutions; to promote interdisciplinary teaching programmes on the campus by coordinating amongst teachers and also to make policy for sharing of academic and research and development infrastructure; to promote the choice based credit system in the university departments, the affiliated colleges and recognized institutions;

Board of University Departments and Interdisciplinary studies shall work out and initiate use of technology in delivery of education. They shall promote the face-to-face and e-learning process in classroom teaching, use of mini-research and maxi research projects as an integral part of postgraduate learning. Efforts will be made to initiate new approaches and methodology for assessing learning by students as a continuous online process. They shall recommend to the Vice-Chancellor the posts of university teachers (including aided posts and the posts for the purposes of sub-section (2) of section 8) to be filled by selection, who possess the prescribed minimum and additional qualification; emoluments and the number of posts to be filled; and the number of posts under sub-clause (i), which may be reserved for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, Vimukta Jatis (De-Notified Tribes) or Nomadic Tribes or Other Backward Classes.(m) to undertake any other task as may be assigned by the university authorities to carry out the objectives of the Board of University Departments and Interdisciplinary Studies and of the university.

Shri Kedarsingh Rotele, Hon. Vice-President, Gram Utkarsh Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur shed light on the fact that there shall be a Board of Post-Graduate Education in Colleges with broad objectives of initiating and strengthening of quality post-graduate programmes in various disciplines of learning in colleges. According to the act, the Board of Post-Graduate Education in Colleges shall meet not less than four times in a year. The Board of Post-Graduate Education in Colleges shall consist of the following members, namely: the Pro-Vice-Chancellor - Chairperson; the Deans of faculties and Associate Deans, if any; one faculty-wise expert from other universities, nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, each having minimum experience of five years as a professor; three faculty-wise heads of departments in colleges, with minimum experience of five years as a recognized post-graduate teacher, from post-graduate centres in colleges, preferably from different districts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor; Directors of all sub-campuses; Deputy Registrar of the administrative section concerned, shall act as the Secretary of the Board.

Dr. Chandansingh Rotele, Hon. President, Gram Utkarsh Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur said that The Board of Post-Graduate Education in Colleges shall have the following powers and duties, namely to recommend creation of a new post-graduate centre in a particular discipline or a new course in the existing post-graduate centre in an affiliated college; creating synergy for the growth of the post-graduate centers at district level through district sub-campuses; initiating and encouraging the use of technology in a blended form of education in the post-graduate centers; propagating and keep track of quality enhancement in post-graduate centers by initiating teachers capacity enhancement activities; initiating research and development activities in post-graduate centers; undertaking any other task as may be assigned by the university authorities so as to carry out objectives of the Board of Post-Graduate Education in Colleges.

NEW EDUCATION POLICY, 2020

Date; 19th April, 2023

Introduction: A session on 'The New Education Policy (NEP), 2020 was organised in the college during the Faculty Dev. Prog. on 19th April, 2023. During the session, **Dr. Indrayani, Jhulel Institue of Technology, Bokhara, Nagpur** guided regarding NEP 2020. She said that NEP is an appropriate response to the current problems in the country with the traditional and rich heritage of the country. She said that the policy is reorientation to the cultural and traditional roots of the country with the touch to the modern trends. She said that the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 heralds a paradigm shift in India's educational landscape, aiming to revamp the traditional system to foster holistic development and innovation. Drawing parallels from the epic Mahabharata, particularly the character of Ashwatthama, provides profound insights into the essence of NEP 2020. In the Mahabharata, Ashwatthama is portrayed as a fierce warrior possessing unparalleled skills. However, his potential was overshadowed by his rigid adherence to outdated strategies and inability to adapt to changing circumstances. Despite his prowess, Ashwatthama's failure to evolve ultimately led to his downfall.

She said that though NEP integrates the Indian Knowledge System, it is not traditional or religious as some may believe. As a matter of fact, the NEP is very secular and inclusive. It does not want the young generation to be shackled by the age-old and rudimentary traditions and baseless norms. But it wants a generation that is very realistic, open- minded with the scientific temperament with the respect for all the cultures of the world. It emphasizes flexibility, multidisciplinary learning, and the integration of technology to equip students with contemporary skills essential for the 21st-century world. Just as Ashwatthama's reluctance to adapt proved detrimental, NEP 2020 emphasizes the need for educational institutions to evolve and embrace change to remain relevant.

During the question answer session, one of the major issue that the participant of the prog. had in their minds had been if NEP would provide any solution to the grave problem of unemployment in India. She responded that the new India focuses on producing a cadre of the entrepreneur who will not have to wander from pillar to post for employment. As a matter of fact, those having qualities would start playing the role of job- provider to the lesser advantage groups. so that no individual would remain unemployed.

She said that the previous education system often prioritized rote learning and examinations, neglecting holistic development. NEP 2020 advocates for a well-rounded education that nurtures critical thinking, creativity, and emotional intelligence, akin to the multifaceted growth required for success in diverse fields, as exemplified in Ashwatthama's journey.

Conclusion: The prog. provided a comprehensive view regarding NEP and disbursed a host of misconceptions regarding NEP. The prog. was coordinated and the vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. Rachana Dhadade.
